Syllabus

Module 1: Introduction to PowerShell. This module introduces PowerShell in Office 365, and describes how to setup and establish a connection using PowerShell to the cloud.

Module 2: Recipient Management. This module will cover what tools are available to manage mailboxes, mail users, contacts, distribution group, and dynamic distribution groups.

Module 3: Provisioning. This module will cover creating a new provisioning request, checking the status of an existing provisioning request and removing a provisioning request.

Module 4: Permissions. This module will cover how to determine what RBAC roles a user or group has, as well as how we can create, assign, and customize roles for administration of Exchange and Recipients.

Module 5: Compliance and Reporting. This module will cover Multi-Mailbox search, Transport rules, Retention Policies, Message Classification, Archiving, and Journaling.

Module 6: Organizational Settings. This module will cover Throttling policy as well as Transport configuration for the Organization.

Module 7: Mailbox Options. This module we will cover things you can modify for a mailbox like: inbox rules, autoreply configuration, Junk email configuration, Calendar Configuration, etc.

Module 8: Exchange ActiveSync. This module we will cover how to create, modify, and delete activesync device policies, as well as how to gather activesync data for your organization and for specific users.

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
